CBBC COVID-19 (coronavirus) Regional Response Update 13 February 2020

In order to help our members better navigate the confusing array of regional policies regarding the recent COVID-19 outbreak in China, CBBC has assembled reports from our 13 offices in China, and prepared this regional policy report.

Common Measures

Since 10 February 2020, almost all provinces have resumed normal working hours, even though schools and kindergartens remain closed in most places. Most educational institutions have adopted remote learning arrangements. Some municipalities have also issued special regulations for working parents to allow one parent to stay at home.

Travel restrictions and special requirements for long-distance travellers remain in place, with the usual obligation to self-quarantine for 14 days. Although initially applied only to travellers from Wuhan, most local governments apply these rules to all non-local arrivals.

A resumption of normal business operations is generally encouraged, even though some provincial governments require special approval and a strict monitoring regime.

Most provinces have also implemented special customs policies for emergency-related goods and donations.

Business Support

The majority of provinces and local governments have announced preferential policies for local and foreign businesses.

The most common measures include:

- 1) Preferential tax and social security policies, with filing deadlines deferred or suspended
- 2) Direct financial support for heavily affected businesses
- 3) Rent reductions or suspension
- 4) Preferential loan and financing support
- 5) Reduced utility fees
- 6) Bespoke legal and administrative aid
- 7) Employment support and special labour regulations regarding quarantined employees

Disclaimer

Given the fluidity of the situation on the ground and difficult work situation for colleagues in China, these regional reports can only provide a snapshot of the current situation. Nonetheless, we are striving to continue to improve our reporting during this unfolding crisis and aim to provide members with an accurate picture of the situation on the ground.
