Summary of position:

Primary responsibilities:

- Carrying out pre audits of quality and ethical, giving appropriate feedback and assisting the manufacturing sites with putting improvement plans into place
 - Assist to manage on site audit program for 3rd and 2nd party audits of our manufacturing partners
 - Ensure satisfactory follow up of all 3rd and 2nd party audits within given timelines
 - Escalate any audits issues that cannot be resolved at site to Head of Quality and Compliance and UK Quality and Compliance manager
 - Evaluate the quality and ethical compliance via conducting pre audits and reviewing certificate/reports of new manufacturing sites as part of supplier onboarding process, e.g. ISO13485, BRC, SMETA, BSCI etc.
 - Maintain all required documentation as evidence of compliance
 - Closely follow developments in legislation and new best practices and cascade information to the factories
 - Building engagement with the factories
 - Liaise with UK Technical team and provide key updates on China suppliers where necessary.
 - Any other tasks assigned by UK office and Head of Quality and Compliance
